

Montana Distillery Deliveries

A Montana distillery producing less than 25,000 gallons of product annually may deliver its product directly to a state agency liquor store if the distillery uses its own equipment, trucks, and employees to do so. The amount of product delivered may not be less than a case. The department must invoice agency liquor stores for products received from a distillery.

Allowed

- The distillery may deliver products directly to the liquor warehouse.
- The distillery may deliver products directly to agency liquor stores.
- The distillery may use a common carrier to deliver the liquor to the department.
- The distillery may deliver products directly or use a common carrier to deliver liquor to an industry trade show.

Not Allowed

- Products may not be delivered directly to retail licensees.
- Products may not be delivered directly to consumers.
- Products may not be delivered directly to catered events.

All licensees must comply with all Federal and Montana alcoholic beverage laws and rules.
