

Montana Distilleries

A distillery producing less than 25,000 gallons of product annually may deliver its product directly to a state agency liquor store if the distillery uses the distillery's own equipment, trucks, and employees to deliver the product. The amount of product delivered may not be less than a case. Agency liquor stores must be invoiced by the department for products received from a distillery.

Allowed

- The distillery may deliver products directly to the liquor warehouse.
- The distillery may deliver products directly to agency liquor stores.
- The distillery may use a common carrier for delivery of the liquor to the department.

Not Allowed

- Product may not be delivered directly to retail licensees.
- Product may not be delivered directly to consumers.

All licensees must comply with all Federal and Montana alcoholic beverage laws and rules.
