

April 12: Identifying a Licensed Marijuana Business

A licensed marijuana business must be approved by the Cannabis Control Division (CCD). Approval is obtained by application to the division, followed by licensing and inspection. The licensed marijuana business must test their products and follow the laws and rules established by the state of Montana.

How do you know if a business is licensed?



Employees are required to wear their department-issued worker permits in a way that is clearly visible to the customer.



Licensed businesses are issued a certificate from the state. This certificate should be visibly posted in the dispensary. *CCD also provides a list of all licensed businesses on our website.



Licensed businesses may not provide free marijuana to customers. A licensed business is permitted to offer free apparel and paraphernalia as giveaways.



Licensed marijuana businesses may only operate between the hours of 9 a.m. and 8 p.m.
