USING CADASTRAL TO FIND YOUR GEOCODE



In this step-by-step tutorial, we will show you how to find the geocode for your principal residence or long-term rental.

A geocode is a 17-digit code that identifies your principal residence. By law, you must include your principal residences, or long-term rental property geocode on your homestead or long-term rental application. Without the geocode, we can't identify your property and won't be able to process your application.

Your geocode is available on Montana Cadastral. Cadastral is a database maintained by the Montana State Library. It allows the public to view information about public and private land ownership in Montana, including your geocode.

So let's get started!












When you see your property information, select "Tax Year 2025" on the right-hand side of the page.
